

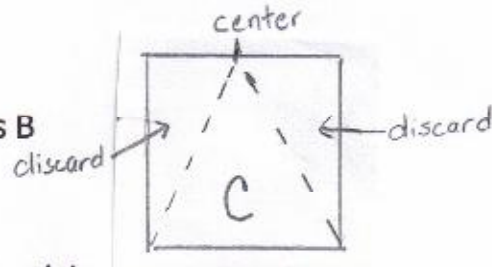
"Starry Log" ---- BOM June 2011

A- (2) 4 7/8" squares dark fabric-save a 3" strip for sashing

B- (2) 4 7/8" squares light background fabric

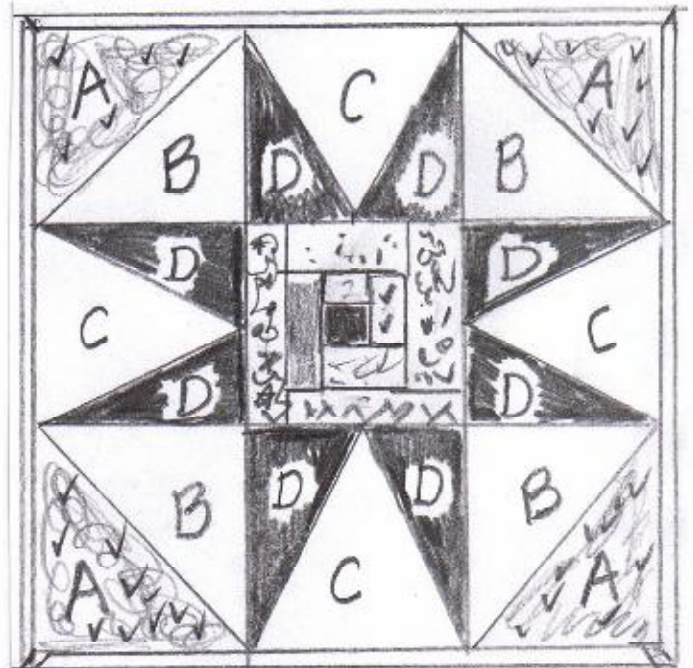
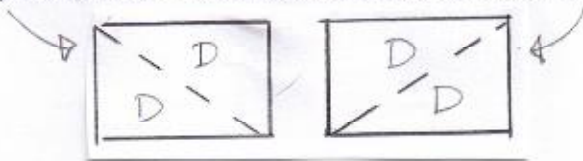
C- (4) 4 7/8" squares light background fabric same as B

-cut as pictured



D- (4) 2 3/4" X 5 1/4" rectangles contrast fabric for star points

-cut (2) diagonally in this direction, and (2) diagonally in this direction--you will have 8 triangles



Pieced Log Cabin logs-

E-(1) 1 1/2" square fabric same as A

F- (1) 1 1/4" X 1 1/2" rectangle med or dark fabric

G- (1) 1 1/4" X 2 1/4" rectangle med or dark fabric

H- (1) 1 1/4" X 2 1/4" rectangle med or dark fabric

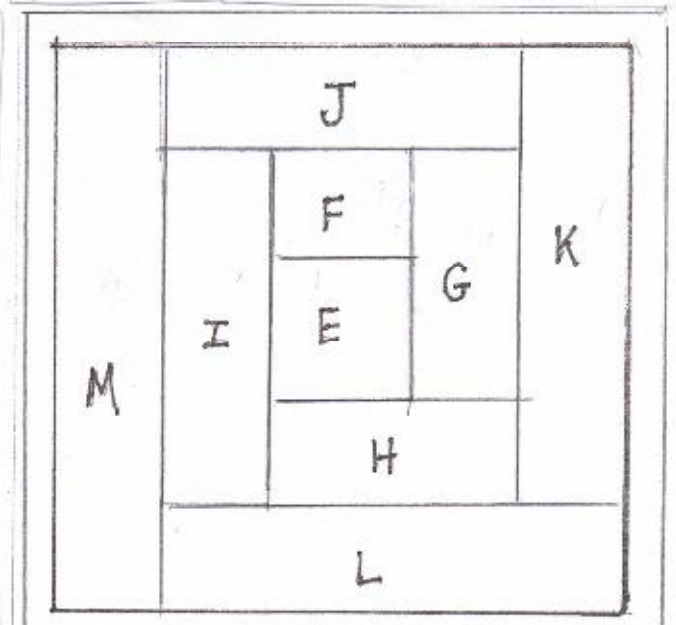
I- (1) 1 1/4" X 3" rectangle med or dark fabric

J- (1) 1 1/4" X 3" fabric as above

K- (1) 1 1/4" X 3 3/4" fabric as above

L- (1) 1 1/4" X 3 3/4" fabric as above

M- (1) 1 1/4" X 4 1/2" fabric as above



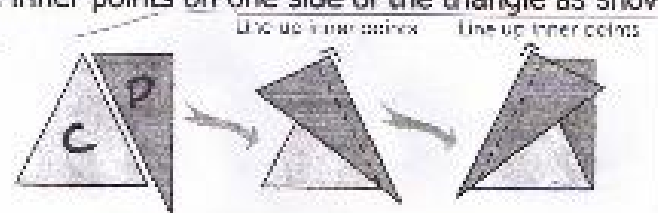
Sewing:

1. Make 4- A/B units by drawing a diagonal line on B's, corner to corner.

Lay right sides together with D and sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away on both sides of line as pictured. Cut on drawn line and press toward A.



2. Construct the C/D square by lining up the inner points on one side of the triangle as shown. Sew and press seam to the darker fabric.



Repeat on the second side and press seam to the darker fabric. Continue with the other 3 C/D blocks. Square up with rotary ruler and cutter to $4\frac{1}{2}$ ", if needed.

3. Lay out the log cabin to correspond to the drawing. Begin sewing F to E. Press seam to center. Continue now sewing G to E/F. Again press seam to center. Continue sewing the logs in ABC order with M log the last to be added. Press and trim to $4\frac{1}{2}$ ". Your log cabin should look just like the drawing!
4. Assemble rows as shown. Press in opposite directions.
5. Pinning at intersections, sew rows together. Press towards middle row.
